SING & PLAY

Play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression.



The Fun Music Company *SING & PLAY* unit includes four complete folk song arrangements which are designed to help students develop their accuracy, fluency, control and expression.

COMPOSE

Improvise and compose music for a range of purposes using the inter-related dimensions of music.



The Fun Music Company *COMPOSE* unit is designed around improvising and composing music. “Inter-related dimensions of music” means elements of music: pitch, rhythm, dynamics, expression, timbre etc, which are all explored in this program.

AURAL

Listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing aural memory.



The Fun Music Company *AURAL* unit is designed to help children recall sounds with increasing aural memory.

SING & PLAY

Use and understand staff and other musical notations.



Through the practice of always having music staff and notations on the screen in the Fun Music Company *SING & PLAY* unit, pupils will learn and understand music notations through this program.
